Duties will include (brief):

the feeding and daily cleaning out of the wildlife casualties in our care,  
assessing and treating casualties brought in daily as well as those already in care,  
emergency call-out duties,  
nights on-call (staying overnight in the hospital),  
telephone answering, dealing with the public & some office work,  
aviary and enclosure cleaning and maintenance and general cleaning etc within the hospital,  
driving the charity vehicles for casualty collections etc.

Experience of wildlife care and rehabilitation preferred.

Full training programme in place.

Must be confident to work alone and as part of a team.

Will include weekend work and nights on-call – variable rota, averaging 5 days per week.

Applicants must have a full, clean driving licence.

Applicants must live within a 20 mile radius of the hospital, or be prepared to relocate to within this distance.
